ENGLISH DEPARTMENT English 399 GUIDELINES

English 399 (Independent Study) is open to Senior Majors, Senior Minors, and Majors with Junior Standing in the English Department. A 399 should be focused on a clearly defined subject matter of genuine intellectual and academic substance. The subject matter should be one that is not normally covered in regular course work. 399 is a full credit course. It may not be taken P/N.

Applications: Proposals must be submitted a week before departmental pre-registration for the quarter in which the 399 is to be undertaken. *Your application must include a signature from the instructor with whom you plan to work, a detailed proposal of the work to be done, a "syllabus" in which you outline your work for each week of the quarter, and an outline of how you plan to be evaluated.*

Procedure: Independent Studies meet at least one hour each week. There will be a clearly defined reading list/program of study worked out with the instructor before the course begins.

Deadline: The final written project is due at the beginning of Finals Week at the end of the quarter during which the 399 is conducted.

Approval: This application must be approved by the Undergraduate Committee before the student may register.
